

What if something happens and I lose this insurance coverage?

Orthodontic insurance benefits are NOT paid out in one lump sum. The payments from your insurance carrier are spread out over the forecast number of months of treatment. (This is different than other dental insurance benefits!) If you have \$1500 lifetime maximum available, and treatment is thought to take 15 months, you may count on \$100 a month. If it takes 24 months, that amounts to about \$62 each month.

If you lose orthodontic insurance benefits after 6 months of a 24 month forecast treatment plan, you will only receive 6/24ths payments from your provider, or about 25% of what was expected.

If this happens to you, new payment arrangements must be made in our office. Please do not wait to make new payment arrangements!
