## What does Dismissed Really Mean?

Being dismissed from a health care practice means that there is no scheduled appointment for a patient's return for follow-up. If you have any concerns, however, you should know that you are welcome to call our office and we will roll out the red carpet.

Some of the things you may be calling our office about could include a lost retainer, or a broken retainer, or one of your retainers needs adjusting.

Since the original payment arrangements included follow-up visits with retainers for approximately one year, you should know office visit fees will apply for patients who have been dismissed.
